

## **Mennonite Brethren: The Real Messiah**

If you have wondered how the One claiming fulfillment of 4,000+ years of Messianic prophecy by Israel's sages could support the disintegration of the Law and the replacement of Israel with Gentile Christianity....

How did the One mistakenly identified as Jesus Christ in the English translations of the Bible, receive recognition as the promised Messiah by nearly half of first century Israel's Jewish population? So scholars affirm. The answer is that He fulfilled ancient Hebraic prophecy.

Suppose, however, that he had:

- Promoted the eating of swine's flesh, universally considered by Jews to be an abomination?
- Had long hair, as though He were taking a Nazarite vow, yet drank wine?
- Come with a Greek name, adapted from a false deity?
- Disregarded the covenant sign of the 7th day Sabbath?
- Replaced a covenant which the Law affirmed was eternal?
- Nailed the Law, revered by Jewish sages, to the cross?
- Failed to consummate His marriage to Israel?
- Instead wooed a new bride: the Gentile Church?
- Founded a NEW, rival religion to Judaism called Christianity?

All being "extra-biblical" events, which the prophets forgot to mention that the Real Messiah would do in what the world knows as the "Old Testament". How many Jews would have accepted Him as the promised Messiah foretold in the Law, the Psalms, and the Prophets? Not many if at all, and yet today this is what the Church claims that the Messiah did. Imagine the remarkableness of performing such a feat: the

equivalent of a Rabbi arriving in America and converting 50% of Christians to orthodox Judaism in just 3? years, and that with the bonus of modern technology and transportation! How such a great reformation? The answer is simply that the first century believers did not believe like the Church believes today. As the apostle Luke wrote, "Thou seest brothers, how many thousands of Jews there are which believe: and they are all zealous for the Law." (Acts 21:20b)

The truth is that the one whom the world mistakenly knows as Jesus did not have a Greek name, nor did He convert half of Judaism to a new religion called Christianity. Instead He fulfilled the prophetic expectation of an ancient faith which had long been set in existence. Nor did He bring about the system of traditions of men which we find in the Churches today. In fact, he condemned it, saying, "It becometh us to fulfill all righteousness" (Mt 3:15); "For I am not come to destroy, but to fulfill (I.e. fill full, obey completely)" (Mt 5:17). "For if ye fulfill the royal Law according to the Scripture (Note that the "Old Testament" was the only "Scripture" at this point in time), ye do well: but if ye... commit sin, ye are convinced of the law as transgressors" (Ja 2:8,9). "Howbeit in vain do they worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men. For laying aside the commandment of the Almighty, ye hold the tradition of men... And he said unto them, Full well ye reject the commandment of the Almighty, that ye may keep your own tradition.... Making the word of the Almighty of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things ye do." (Mar 7:7-9,13)

Who then nailed the law to the cross? The Roman Church affirms that they, and not the Real Messiah, did that; initiating the change of times and Law (Dan 7:25) which has been evolving for almost two millennia; ever since the Real Messiah was here; and which the real Messiah warned us against (Mt 24:15, Mk 13:14). That which attempts to override and replace the Almighty's Anointed is what both the "New Testament" and Biblical scholars identify as "anti-messiah" or "antichrist"; that is, a counterfeit which promotes a distortion of the original gospel (Gal 1:6,7).

### **If You Saw The Real Messiah And Antichrist Standing Side By Side Could You Tell The Difference?**

"And if he that cometh preacheth another messiah, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him." (2 Cor 12:4)

"Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;... For the mystery of iniquity doth already work..." (2Th 2:3,7)

The Real Messiah has come, He was eventually forgotten, and so far as humanity is concerned, He has now been "replaced". The inhabitants of the earth have married the daughter of a strange god (Mal 2:11). It is time to return to the One we have revolted against (Isa 31:6).
