

## **Quote from Isaac Newton**

"About the Times of the end, a body of men will be raised up who will turn their attention to the prophecies and insist upon their literal interpretation in the midst of much clamour and opposition."

That quote came from Sir Isaac Newton (1642-1727). That amazing prediction is coming true in our day as what was begun in the Protestant Reformation is moving rapidly towards completion. Many have given the year 1996 for the start of the Nazarene "awakening". Nazarenes believe in the literal fulfillment of the prophecies regarding all the tribes of Israel, their predicted return to the land of Israel, the literal application of the Torah or the Law of Moses, and that the kingdom of Elohim is coming to this earth. As can be expected, this is happening " in the midst of much clamour and opposition."

It is equally amazing that the same sort of awakening is also happening among Orthodox Jews. Ancient rabbis have for centuries taught that the lost tribes of Israel would also be returned to their promised land and reunited with Judah. Most students of the bible will recall that Israel was split into two kingdoms after the reign of Solomon and that the tribes of the northern ten tribes were carried off by Assyria. The southern kingdom remained in the land, with the exception of the Babylonian period of captivity, until the time of the Roman Empire. Many modern Jews are expecting that the tribes of the northern kingdom will soon be returning in great numbers in accordance with biblical prophecies.

At the same time Christian Zionists have become very supportive of the modern State of Israel. This is happening mostly in the United States of America which is the only friend the State of Israel has in almost the whole world. Christian Zionists believe that the Jews have been re-established in Canaan as a fulfillment of prophecy. Political authorities in Israel are welcoming the support of Christian Zionists and have begun to recognize the Nazarene movement as well. To some degree the age old and very bitter Christian-Jewish antagonism has warily become a side issue.

The ground is being prepared for the eventual reunion of Israel (the northern tribes) with Judah. What most Protestant Christians don't realize is that they embody the so called "lost tribe of Israel". This interpretation is shared by both Orthodox Jews and the Nazarene movement. Hence both sides have very active teaching ministries in proclaiming to Protestant Christians their true identity and destiny. Hence the "clamour and opposition" because most Christians are reluctant to take a literal interpretation of prophecy or to believe that they are the literal seed of Abraham.

Most Christians also, although they may not want to admit it, do not believe that a literal kingdom of peace is coming to this earth. Yet the prophecies are very clear. Judah and Israel will be reunited after which the Messiah will come. All the tribes will repent and apply the Torah fully in an administration that will

bring salvation to the nations. The "Millennium" that is coming is quite literal. Elohim will rule on this earth with Jerusalem as His capital. This is what Yeshua was referring to when He announced the coming reign of the heavens.

I have committed myself to this ministry as well and invite you to join me. Believe in the literal fulfillment of the prophetic utterances. As Israelites we must repent of our lawless ways and our idolatries which are legion. At this time, even as we call ourselves Christians, we have not yet realized the depth of our rebellion to the ways of Elohim or the depth of the forgiveness that we have in Yeshua. I pray that your ears may be opened and that you will believe in what the Scriptures literally say.
