

Salvation is not about going to heaven

I have no choice but to speak boldly to you about our coming salvation. Most of you, if not everyone of you, have not yet comprehended the magnitude of what the Elohim of Israel will do in the later days. The process, now underway, is nothing less than the revealing of the sons of Elohim. Those who return to YHWH, the Elohim of Israel, are to be rulers and priests in the kingdom that is coming. They will reign with Yeshua Messiah for a thousand years.

Most of you, if not all of you, do not really study the Scriptures to see what is actually written there. Those who do read the Bible, simply read into the Scriptures the doctrines that you inherited from your fathers, your seminaries and your mother church which is Roman Catholicism. I wonder sometimes why, when all of Christendom believes nearly the same things, it doesn't make you suspicious. After all, did not Yeshua say that we are to enter into His kingdom through a narrow gate. I tell you truly that the world's perception of salvation does not conform with what the Scriptures teach.

Furthermore, it never ceases to amaze me that I am preaching a message of repentance to my own Mennonite people and to our converts or "Companions." To be certain, there is hardly a more well meaning and genuine people on the face of this earth than our Mennonites. I'm sure that all of you believe that you have already repented and that you are all living at least relatively sinless lives. But once again I ask you, does this not make you suspicious? Do not the Scriptures say that all our righteousness are as filthy rags and to be aware when all men speak well of us? It is very difficult to get a righteous person to repent. Yet again I tell you truly, that unless you repent, you will in no way enter into the kingdom of heaven.

Last week I gave you a very brief overview of the grassroots movement that is sweeping through the Christian church all around the world and especially here in North America. The Nazarene Israel Movement is a spontaneous departure from organized Christianity and a return to the original, biblically based faith of the apostles. Rather than repeating some of the movements basic characteristics, I will simply comment that there is not much truth left in the church system....if any! Neither are you who are ministers doing anything to release your captives. Instead you continue to preach the same the same empty messages and outright falsehoods that you inherited from those before you. The Nazarene movement is nothing less then a complete break with the religious world that you represent.... a coming out of the Babylonian system.

Brethren, you have to repent. Salvation is not about going to heaven when you die! Neither is salvation a rapture out of this world! Furthermore, if you are waiting for a dramatic and highly visible "second coming", the kingdom of heaven will be upon you before you are even aware of it. Such teachings have given you comfort in the past, but it is a false comfort. Perhaps there are some of you out there who are courageous enough accept this. Truly, if you seek the Elohim of

Israel, He will confirm to you what I am saying. The rest of you can consider this as a warning and a testimony that you will hear again and again. Brethren, you need to repent!

The great miracle of our day is the resurrection of Israel and that miracle is well underway. Just as the prophets foretold, in the later days the Elohim of Israel will regather His people from all the nations where He scattered them. Elohim will reunite the ten lost tribes with the tribe of Judah and make them one again. He will take away their unrighteousness and they will be His people. The revealing of the sons of Elohim and the resurrection of Israel are one and the same event. This is the beginning of the kingdom of heaven that Yeshua announced almost two thousand years ago. Truly, the reign of Elohim has already begun!
